Section 81-1272, Reissue Revised Statutes of 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 81-1272 Sections 81-1272 to 81-1277 shall be known and 4 may be cited as the Business Development Partnership Act. The act 5 terminates on January 1, 2015. б Sec. 2. Section 81-1274, Reissue Revised Statutes of 7 Nebraska, is amended to read: 8 81-1274 (1) There is hereby created the Business Development Services Program in the Existing Business Assistance 9 Division of the Department of Economic Development. The division 10 shall be responsible for the administration of the program and shall 11 12 have the power and authority to contract for services as provided in 13 sections 81-1275 and 81-1276. 14 (2) Beginning fiscal year 2011-12, no General Funds shall be appropriated to carry out the Business Development Partnership 15 16 Act. 17 Sec. 3. (1) This legislative bill is a result of the work of the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee of the Legislature 18 pursuant to a legislative study resolution, LR542, One Hundred First 19 20 Legislature, Second Session, 2010, introduced on April 1, 2010. 21 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature that a budget reduction of \$240,000 of General Funds appropriated to the Department 22 23 of Economic Development in fiscal year 2011-12 and in fiscal year 2012-13 be made as a result of the enactment of this legislative 24 25 bill.
