A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to public buildings; to amend sections 82-319,
2 85-106.01, and 85-304.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3 Nebraska; to change provisions relating to use of
4 portions of appropriated funds for works of art in new
5 construction; and to repeal the original sections.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 82-319, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 82-319 All boards, agencies, commissions, or departments
4 of state government shall, ~~after January 1, 1979, until January 1,~~
5 2012, and after January 1, 2022, spend at least one percent of any
6 appropriation for the original construction of any state building for
7 the acquisition of works of art. The works of art may be an integral
8 part of the structure, attached to the structure, detached within or
9 outside of the structure, or may be exhibited by the board, agency,
10 commission, or department in other public facilities.

11 Sec. 2. Section 85-106.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
12 Nebraska, is amended to read:

13 85-106.01 ~~After~~ Until January 1, 2012, and after January
14 1, 1979, 2022, at least one percent of any appropriation for the
15 original construction of any public building under the supervision of
16 the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska shall be spent for
17 the acquisition of works of art. The works of art may be an integral
18 part of the structure, attached to the structure, detached within or
19 outside of the structure, or may be exhibited by the Board of Regents
20 of the University of Nebraska in other public facilities.

21 Sec. 3. Section 85-304.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
22 Nebraska, is amended to read:

23 85-304.01 ~~After~~ Until January 1, 2012, and on and after
24 January 1, 1979, 2022, at least one percent of any appropriation for
25 the original construction of any public building under the

1 supervision of the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges
2 shall be spent for the acquisition of works of art. The works of art
3 may be an integral part of the structure, attached to the structure,
4 detached within or outside of the structure, or may be exhibited by
5 the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges in other public
6 facilities.

7 Sec. 4. Original sections 82-319, 85-106.01, and
8 85-304.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
