Section 1. Section 38-613, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 38-613 (1) The specific medical functions to be performed 4 by a certified nurse midwife within the scope of permitted practice 5 prescribed by section 38-611 shall be described in the practice 6 agreement which shall be reviewed and approved by the board. A copy 7 of the agreement shall be maintained on file with the board as a 8 condition of lawful practice under the Certified Nurse Midwifery 9 Practice Act.

(2) A certified nurse midwife shall perform the functions 10 detailed in the practice agreement only under the supervision of the 11 12 licensed practitioner responsible for the medical care of the 13 patients described in the practice agreement. If the collaborating 14 licensed practitioner named in the practice agreement becomes 15 temporarily unavailable, the certified nurse midwife may perform the 16 authorized medical functions only under the supervision of another licensed practitioner designated as a temporary substitute for that 17 18 purpose by the collaborating licensed practitioner.

19 (3) A certified nurse midwife may perform authorized20 medical functions only in the following settings:

(a) In a licensed or certified health care facility as an
employee or as a person granted privileges by the facility;

(b) In the primary office of a licensed practitioner or
in any setting authorized by the collaborating licensed practitioner;
or , except that a certified nurse midwife shall not attend a home

1 delivery; or

2 (c) Within an organized public health agency.
3 (4) The department shall, after consultations with the
4 board, adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the

5 Certified Nurse Midwifery Practice Act.
