A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Department of Health and Human Services;
2 to amend section 81-3114, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3 Nebraska; to change provisions relating to appointment of
4 the chief executive officer; and to repeal the original
5 section.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-3114, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 81-3114 The Governor shall appoint the chief executive
4 officer of the Department of Health and Human Services who shall have
5 recognized and demonstrated knowledge and expertise in the delivery
6 of publicly funded health and human services programs and services.
7 The appointee shall have demonstrated executive experience in public
8 administration or not-for-profit service delivery systems. and
9 administrative experience in an executive capacity.—The chief
10 executive officer shall report to the Governor and serve at the
11 pleasure of the Governor. The chief executive officer shall be
12 subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the members of the
13 Legislature. Not less than one week before the date of the public
14 hearing on the proposed appointee for the post of chief executive
15 officer, he or she shall report to the Health and Human Services
16 Committee of the Legislature on the qualifications he or she
17 possesses to meet the requirements of this section. The committee
18 report approving recommendation of the appointment shall include
19 specifics on the appointee's qualifications to serve as chief
20 executive officer.
