A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to public health and welfare; to create a task
2	force; to provide for a review and recommendations
3	regarding the use of certain drugs by wards of the state;
4	and to provide for reports.
5	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. (1) The Health and Human Services Committee of
2	the Legislature shall create a task force to examine state policy
3	regarding the prescription of psychotropic drugs for children who are
4	wards of the state and the administration of such drugs to such
5	<u>children.</u>
6	(2) The task force shall review the policy and procedures
7	for prescribing and administering such drugs and make recommendations
8	for changes in such policy and procedures.
9	(3) The task force shall consist of no more than twelve
10	members and may include lay, professional, organizational, and
11	governmental representatives in analyzing and developing a report
12	summarizing such recommendations.
13	(4) The task force shall present a report annually to the
14	Legislature no later than January 1.
