A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to revenue and taxation; to amend section
2 77-27,137.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3 change state aid to counties; to provide an operative
4 date; to repeal the original section; and to declare an
5 emergency.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 77-27,137.03, Reissue Revised Statutes
2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 77-27,137.03 The Legislature shall appropriate funds as
4 aid to counties in an amount equal to a percentage of the total real
5 and personal property valuation of all counties, such percent to be
6 not less than ~~.0075~~zero percent nor more than .0125 percent.

7 Of the appropriation, each county shall receive an equal
8 amount up to thirty thousand dollars and the remaining amount shall
9 be distributed to each county on the basis of the ratio of the total
10 real and personal property valuation in the county to the total real
11 and personal property valuation in the state.

12 The Tax Commissioner shall determine the amount to be
13 distributed to the various counties under this section and certify
14 such amounts to the Director of Administrative Services on or before
15 July 1 of each year. Each amount shall be distributed in nine as
16 nearly as possible equal monthly payments on the last business day of
17 each month beginning in September.

18 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2011.

19 Sec. 3. Original section 77-27,137.03, Reissue Revised
20 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

21 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
22 when passed and approved according to law.
