1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND LEGISLATURE OF  
2 NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2012 the  
4 following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be  
5 submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or  
6 rejection:

7 To amend Article III, section 12:

8 III-12 (1) No person shall be eligible to serve as a  
9 member of the Legislature for four years next after the expiration of  
10 ~~two~~ three consecutive terms regardless of the district represented.

11 (2) Service prior to January 1, 2001, as a member of the  
12 Legislature shall not be counted for the purpose of calculating  
13 consecutive terms in subsection (1) of this section.

14 (3) For the purpose of this section, service in office  
15 for more than one-half of a term shall be deemed service for a term.

16 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the

1 electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska,  
2 Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:

3           A constitutional amendment to change the limit on  
4 legislative terms to three consecutive terms.
