PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND LEGISLATURE OF
 NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the primary election in May 2012 the 4 following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be 5 submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or 6 rejection:

To amend Article III, section 12:

8 III-12 (1) No person shall be eligible to serve as a 9 member of the Legislature for four years next after the expiration of 10 two consecutive terms regardless of the district represented.

(2) Service prior to January 1, 2001, as a member of the Legislature shall not be counted for the purpose of calculating consecutive terms in subsection (1) of this section.

14 (3) For the purpose of this section, service in office
15 for more than one-half of a term shall be deemed service for a term.
16 (4) For purposes of this section, if a member of the
17 Legislature serves for a period beginning on the first Wednesday
18 after the first Monday in January of an odd-numbered year through the

1 first Wednesday after the first Monday in January of the following 2 odd-numbered year, the member is deemed to have served for one-half 3 <u>of a term.</u> 4 Sec. 2.
