PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Introduced by Pirsch, 4.

Read first time January 19, 2011

1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND LEGISLATURE OF
2 NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2012 the
4 following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be
5 submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or
6 rejection:

7 To amend Article III, section 13:

8 III-13 The style of all bills shall be, Be it enacted by
9 the people of the State of Nebraska, and no law shall be enacted
10 except by bill. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature unless by
11 the assent of a majority of all members elected to the Legislature
12 and the yeas and nays on the question of final passage of any bill
13 shall be entered upon the journal, except that any bill that imposes
14 a tax or license fee or increases the rate of a tax or the amount of
15 a license fee shall require a two-thirds vote of all the members
16 elected to the Legislature.

17 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the
18 electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska,

1 Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:

2 A constitutional amendment to require a two-thirds vote
3 of the Legislature to approve any bill that imposes or increases a
4 tax or license fee.
