The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB1006 amends Neb. Rev. Stat. 71-8611 which affords a priority to blind persons with regard to the operation of vending facilities on state property according to the Randolph-Sheppard Act. LB1006 clarifies that bids for vending facilities shall be based on a comparison of product prices in such facilities to ensure optimum competitiveness of the blind.
