**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1030 proposes that changes be made to the Nebraska Rules of the Road that would require a driver of a motor vehicle to leave a distance of no less than 3 feet clearance to avoid colliding with a pedestrian on a roadway; and also requires a driver of a motor vehicle, when overtaking or passing a bicycle or electric personal assistive mobility device traveling in the same direction, leave no less than 3 feet clearance.
