Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1058 would adopt necessary conformity requirement changes to the Employment Security Law and allow Nebraska employers to claim the maximum credit allowed against their federal tax liability under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act.

The bill would also allow the Department of Labor to recover overpayments of unemployment benefits resulting from a claimant's failure to report wages earned while claiming benefits by intercepting federal income tax refunds.

LB 1058 includes clean up amendments to remove unnecessary and outdated language from the Employment Security Law.
