The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

This bill allows for a person to apply, in lieu of the regular license plate, for a license plate that would have a black background, white lettering, and the words "The Beef State" along the top, which is a similar design to the state license plate in the 1950's and 1960's. The fee for this license plate will be \$70, with credit of fifteen percent of the fee for initial issuance and renewal of Beef State license plates to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund and eighty-five percent of the fee to the Highway Trust Fund. The Beef State license plate would be available with a consecutive numbering system beginning with 1 or as a personalized message plate.
