The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

This bill is an alteration to the County Purchasing Act giving County governments the opportunity to sell greater amounts of unusable surplus property, including motor vehicles. This bill would allow counties to free up storage space by ridding themselves of unwanted and unneeded items, as well as provide an opportunity for the Counties to raise a portion of revenue to offset the costs of future purchases.
