The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 36 would amend §71-3305 to allow any city or village which reaches a population of one thousand or more inhabitants to place on the ballot, in the next statewide general election, the question of whether or not to prohibit the addition of fluoride to the water supply of the city or village.

Cities or villages of one thousand or more inhabitants were given, by law, a two year period in which to vote on this issue. That period ended on June 1, 2010. LB 36 would extend that right to cities or villages which reach a population of one thousand or more after June 1, 2010.
