The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 380, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor, is part of the Governor's biennial budget recommendations.

The bill amends Nebraska Revised Statutes section 81-188.02, section 81-188.04, and section 81-188.06 so that certain depreciation charges normally assessed to state agencies, boards, and commissions by the Administrative Services Task Force for Building Renewal for capital improvement projects related to facilities, structures, or buildings owned by the University of Nebraska, Nebraska State Colleges, or the State of Nebraska, shall not be assessed or paid for the period that began July 1, 2009 and ends June 30, 2013. LB380 extends the suspension of the depreciation assessment for two more years through June 30, 2013.

This legislative bill has an operative date of July 1, 2011 and contains the emergency clause.
