Introducer's Statement of Intent

LB421

Date of Hearing: January 26, 2011

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 421 would increase the Nebraska Game and Park Commission's annual park entry permit fees.

The annual entry permit fee for a resident motor vehicle would increase from twenty to not more than twenty-five dollars.

The annual entry permit fee for a non-resident motor vehicle would increase from twenty-five to not more than thirty dollars.

The fee for a temporary resident entry permit would increase from four to not more than five dollars.

The fee for a temporary non-resident entry permit would increase from five to not more than six dollars.

The entities designated by the Commission as permit agents would be entitled to collect and retain a fee of not more than one dollar. The current fee for permit agents is not less than twenty-five cents and not more than thirty-five cents.

The fee increases would become effective on January 1, 2012.
