The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of Legislative Bill 462 is to repeal Section 87-220 of the trade name statutes and to include an additional statutory damages remedy for misuse of a trade name.

Currently, Section 87-220 provides a criminal penalty for failing to register a trade name with the Secretary of State.

The existing penalty is inconsistent with common-law trade name rights and case law on the subject matter.
