The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB584 is intended to provide deployed military personnel with the ability to store their motor vehicle or trailer when it is not in use during the period of their deployment. Current statute allows for an Affidavit for Storage and Non-use to be used by the applicant to avoid paying annual registration fees, however, such affidavit may only be used at the expiration of the current registration period and requires the vehicle to remain off the road for at least one year before it may be re-registered. LB584 allows additional flexibility for Nebraska's soldiers deployed overseas, granting them the ability to register their motor vehicles and trailers, and pay the corresponding registration fees, for the period in which their vehicles or trailers are actually in use.
