## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

### **LB605**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 605 allows electors to register to vote and vote on Election Day by completing a registration application. The elector may register and vote at either the election commissioner or county clerk's office or at his or her polling place.

The elector wishing to registrar and vote on Election Day must provide government or university issued photo identification and proof of current address if the address on the photo identification is not current and does not match the application. Acceptable proof of address includes a utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that is current and that shows the name and address of the elector as they appear on the application.
