The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 636 would clarify that learning communities are local educational authorities with respect to member school districts and their students for purposes of the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 and that designated employees are authorized to receive personally identifiable information about students in their learning community. The measure would also modify requirements for reporting information to learning community coordinating councils and for the councils to report to the Education Committee.
