Legislative Bill 647 is an act to protect the fundamental liberties, rights, and privileges granted under the United States Constitution and the Nebraska Constitution by making a clear policy in Nebraska that the use of any foreign law, legal code, or system in court decisions renders such decisions void and unenforceable if the law, legal code, or system violates the fundamental liberties, rights, and privileges protected under the U.S. Constitution and the Nebraska Constitution.
