The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 665 broadens the existing provisions relating to criminal child enticement by prohibiting the solicitation, coaxing, enticement, or luring (including attempt) of any child under the age of fourteen years into any place with the intent to seclude the child from his or her parent, guardian, or other legal custodian or the general public.
