Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 673 would amend Neb. Rev. Stat. § 42-371 regarding release of judgment and subordination of support order liens. Specifically, the bill would require a judgment creditor to pay the judgment debtor's court costs and attorney's fees in certain situations when the judgment creditor had refused, without a good faith reason, to execute a release or subordination.

LB 673 would also amend the Parenting Act by providing procedures for child custody, child support, parenting time, and visitation proceedings involving a military parent.
