**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The bill will harmonize Neb. Rev. Stat. Secs. 25-1095 and 25-1096 which direct the return of goods or property after the issuance of a writ of replevin. Section 25-1095 allows plaintiffs to specify a date as to when property or goods shall be returned and 25-1096 requires the return of goods or property within 20 days after the writ is issued. The change in language is intended to accommodate intervening circumstances that make it difficult for county sheriff offices to reclaim goods or property within 20 days of the issuance of a replevin.
