**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The bill removes the statutory requirement for each court to send the DMV an alphabetized list of outstanding warrants for arrest by the fifth of each month.

With the development of the State's JUSTICE system that provides for the electronic transmission of court records to the DMV, and the courts' statutory authority to notify the DMV to issue suspensions for failure to comply violations, the requirement has become obsolete.

The bill outright repeals sections 60-3,163 and 60-485.
