The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

This bill makes two changes to the worker's compensation statutes:

First, current law provides that, when an employee is killed in an on the job accident, he or she is entitled to burial expense of \$6,000. LB 906 would change the burial benefit to 13 times the average weekly wage. For 2012, that total would be \$9,230.

The bill would also provide that, if an employee is killed in a compensable accident, and that employer has no dependents, the employee's estate would receive a lump sum payment of \$25,000.
