## LEGISLATIVE BILL 949A

Approved by the Governor April 9, 2012

Introduced by Harms, 48.

FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend Laws 2011, LB374, section 101; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 949, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012; to provide for transfers of funds; to provide for a reduction of appropriations as prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$156,111,873 from the General Fund, \$2,734,444 from Cash Funds, and \$30,676,983 from federal funds for FY2012-13 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 354, Child Welfare Aid, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 949, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012.

There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2012-13 \$156,111,873 General Funds, \$2,734,444 Cash Funds, and \$30,676,983 Federal Funds estimate for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.

There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2012-13 \$2,734,444 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund for state aid for the continuation of the behavioral health provider rate increase.

<u>If Legislative Bill 985A, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012, becomes law, the reduction to the FY2012-13 General Fund appropriation to Program 347 contained in Legislative Bill 985A, One Hundred Contain</u>

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Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012, shall not be made in Program 347 but shall be reduced from Program 354.

If Legislative Bill 993A, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012, becomes law, the FY2012-13 and FY2013-14 General Fund appropriations to Program 347 contained in Legislative Bill 993A, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012, shall be transferred to Program 354 and are hereby appropriated.

If Legislative Bill 820A, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012, becomes law, the FY2012-13 and FY2013-14 General Fund appropriations to Program 347 contained in Legislative Bill 820A, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012, shall be transferred to Program 354 and are hereby appropriated.

If the home visitation program earmark contained in section 47, Legislative Bill 968, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012, becomes law, the earmark shall transfer to Program 354.

Sec. 3. Original Laws 2011, LB374, section 101, is repealed.

Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
