On page 6, strike lines 12 through 19 and all 2 amendments thereto and insert the following new subdivision: 3 "(n) Cooperate with other emergency management agencies 4 and public agencies in the development of emergency management 5 registries which include persons with functional needs and 6 the families and guardians of such persons for purposes of 7 planning for assistance for such persons and their families and 8 guardians before, during, and after a disaster or other emergency. 9 Participation in an emergency management registry by persons with 10 functional needs and their families shall be voluntary. Information 11 obtained by emergency management agencies or other public agencies 12 for such purposes shall not be considered a public record under 13 section 84-712.01. All information acquired pursuant to this 14 subdivision is confidential and cannot be disclosed or released except to other agencies which have a legitimate and official 15 16 interest in the information for carrying out the purposes of this 17 subdivision. Any person acquiring information pursuant to this 18 subdivision who discloses or releases such information in violation 19 of this subdivision is guilty of a Class III misdemeanor. The disclosure or release of such information regarding an individual 20 21 is a separate offense from information disclosed or released

regarding any other individual; and".
