1           1. Strike the original sections and all amendments  
2 thereto and insert the following new sections:

3           Section 1. Section 60-301, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
4 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

5           60-301 Sections 60-301 to 60-3,222 and sections 9 and 10  
6 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Motor Vehicle  
7 Registration Act.

8           Sec. 2. Section 60-393, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
9 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

10          60-393 Any owner who has two or more motor vehicles  
11 or trailers required to be registered under the Motor Vehicle  
12 Registration Act may register all such motor vehicles or trailers  
13 on a calendar-year basis or on an annual basis for the same  
14 registration period beginning in a month chosen by the owner. When  
15 electing to establish the same registration period for all such  
16 motor vehicles or trailers, the owner shall pay the registration  
17 fee, the motor vehicle tax imposed in section 60-3,185, the motor  
18 vehicle fee imposed in section 60-3,190, and the alternative fuel  
19 fee imposed in section 60-3,191 on each motor vehicle for the  
20 number of months necessary to extend its current registration  
21 period to the registration period under which all such motor  
22 vehicles or trailers will be registered. Credit shall be given for  
23 registration paid on each motor vehicle or trailer when the motor

1 vehicle or trailer has a later expiration date than that chosen  
2 by the owner except as otherwise provided in sections 60-3,121,  
3 60-3,122.02, and 60-3,128 and section 10 of this act. Thereafter  
4 all such motor vehicles or trailers shall be registered on an  
5 annual basis starting in the month chosen by the owner.

6 Sec. 3. Section 60-395, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
7 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

8 60-395 (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2)  
9 of this section and sections 60-3,121, 60-3,122.02, and 60-3,128  
10 and section 10 of this act, the registration shall expire and  
11 the registered owner or lessee may, by returning the registration  
12 certificate, the license plates, and, when appropriate, the  
13 validation decals and by either making application on a form  
14 prescribed by the department to the county treasurer of the  
15 occurrence of an event described in subdivisions (a) through (e) of  
16 this subsection or, in the case of a change in situs, displaying  
17 to the county treasurer the registration certificate of such  
18 other state as evidence of a change in situs, receive a refund  
19 of that part of the unused fees and taxes on motor vehicles or  
20 trailers based on the number of unexpired months remaining in the  
21 registration period from the date of any of the following events:

22 (a) Upon transfer of ownership of any motor vehicle or  
23 trailer;

24 (b) In case of loss of possession because of fire, theft,  
25 dismantlement, or junking;

26 (c) When a salvage branded certificate of title is  
27 issued;

1           (d) Whenever a type or class of motor vehicle or trailer  
2 previously registered is subsequently declared by legislative act  
3 or court decision to be illegal or ineligible to be operated or  
4 towed on the public roads and no longer subject to registration  
5 fees, the motor vehicle tax imposed in section 60-3,185, the motor  
6 vehicle fee imposed in section 60-3,190, and the alternative fuel  
7 fee imposed in section 60-3,191;

8           (e) Upon a trade-in or surrender of a motor vehicle under  
9 a lease; or

10           (f) In case of a change in the situs of a motor vehicle  
11 or trailer to a location outside of this state.

12           (2) If the date of the event falls within the same  
13 calendar month in which the motor vehicle or trailer is acquired,  
14 no refund shall be allowed for such month.

15           (3) If the transferor or lessee acquires another motor  
16 vehicle at the time of the transfer, trade-in, or surrender, the  
17 transferor or lessee shall have the credit provided for in this  
18 section applied toward payment of the motor vehicle fees and taxes  
19 then owing. Otherwise, the transferor or lessee shall file a claim  
20 for refund with the county treasurer upon an application form  
21 prescribed by the department.

22           (4) The registered owner or lessee shall make a claim for  
23 refund or credit of the fees and taxes for the unexpired months  
24 in the registration period within sixty days after the date of the  
25 event or shall be deemed to have forfeited his or her right to such  
26 refund or credit.

27           (5) For purposes of this section, the date of the event

1 shall be: (a) In the case of a transfer or loss, the date of  
2 the transfer or loss; (b) in the case of a change in the situs,  
3 the date of registration in another state; (c) in the case of  
4 a trade-in or surrender under a lease, the date of trade-in or  
5 surrender; (d) in the case of a legislative act, the effective date  
6 of the act; and (e) in the case of a court decision, the date the  
7 decision is rendered.

8 (6) Application for registration or for reassignment of  
9 license plates and, when appropriate, validation decals to another  
10 motor vehicle or trailer shall be made within thirty days of the  
11 date of purchase.

12 (7) If a motor vehicle or trailer was reported stolen  
13 under section 60-178, a refund under this section shall not be  
14 reduced for a lost plate charge and a credit under this section may  
15 be reduced for a lost plate charge but the applicant shall not be  
16 required to pay the plate fee for new plates.

17 (8) The county treasurer shall refund the motor vehicle  
18 fee and registration fee from the fees which have not been  
19 transferred to the State Treasurer. The county treasurer shall make  
20 payment to the claimant from the undistributed motor vehicle taxes  
21 of the taxing unit where the tax money was originally distributed.  
22 No refund of less than two dollars shall be paid.

23 Sec. 4. Section 60-396, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
24 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

25 60-396 Whenever the registered owner files an application  
26 with the county treasurer showing that a motor vehicle or trailer  
27 is disabled and has been removed from service, the registered owner

1 may, by returning the registration certificate, the license plates,  
2 and, when appropriate, the validation decals or, in the case of the  
3 unavailability of such registration certificate or certificates,  
4 license plates, or validation decals, then by making an affidavit  
5 to the county treasurer of such disablement and removal from  
6 service, receive a credit for a portion of the registration fee  
7 from the fee deposited with the State Treasurer at the time of  
8 registration based upon the number of unexpired months remaining  
9 in the registration year except as otherwise provided in sections  
10 60-3,121, 60-3,122.02, and 60-3,128 and section 10 of this act.  
11 The owner shall also receive a credit for the unused portion of  
12 the motor vehicle tax and fee based upon the number of unexpired  
13 months remaining in the registration year. When the owner registers  
14 a replacement motor vehicle or trailer at the time of filing  
15 such affidavit, the credit may be immediately applied against  
16 the registration fee and the motor vehicle tax and fee for the  
17 replacement motor vehicle or trailer. When no such replacement  
18 motor vehicle or trailer is so registered, the county treasurer  
19 shall forward the application and affidavit, if any, to the State  
20 Treasurer who shall determine the amount, if any, of the allowable  
21 credit for the registration fee and issue a credit certificate to  
22 the owner. For the motor vehicle tax and fee, the county treasurer  
23 shall determine the amount, if any, of the allowable credit and  
24 issue a credit certificate to the owner. When such motor vehicle  
25 or trailer is removed from service within the same month in which  
26 it was registered, no credits shall be allowed for such month.  
27 The credits may be applied against taxes and fees for new or

1 replacement motor vehicles or trailers incurred within one year  
2 after cancellation of registration of the motor vehicle or trailer  
3 for which the credits were allowed. When any such motor vehicle or  
4 trailer is reregistered within the same registration year in which  
5 its registration has been canceled, the taxes and fees shall be  
6 that portion of the registration fee and the motor vehicle tax and  
7 fee for the remainder of the registration year.

23 Nebraska, is amended to read:

24 60-3,123 (1) Any person who was captured and incarcerated  
25 by an enemy of the United States during a period of conflict with  
26 such enemy and who was discharged or otherwise separated with a  
27 characterization of honorable from or is currently serving in the

1 United States Armed Forces may, in addition to the application  
2 required in section 60-385, apply to the department for license  
3 plates designed to indicate that he or she is a former prisoner of  
4 war.

5 (2) The license plates shall be issued upon the applicant  
6 paying the regular license fee ~~and an additional fee of five~~  
7 ~~dollars~~ and furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that  
8 the applicant was formerly a prisoner of war. ~~The additional~~  
9 ~~fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the~~  
10 ~~Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund.~~ Any number of  
11 motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers, or cabin trailers owned by

20 Nebraska, is amended to read:

21 60-3,125 (1) Any person may, in addition to the  
22 application required by section 60-385, apply to the department  
23 for license plates designed by the department to indicate that the  
24 applicant has received from the federal government an award of a  
25 Purple Heart. The inscription of the plates shall be designed so  
26 as to include a facsimile of the award and beneath any numerical  
27 designation upon the plates pursuant to section 60-370 the words

1 Purple Heart separately on one line and the words Combat Wounded  
2 on the line below.

3 (2) The license plates shall be issued upon payment of  
4 the regular license fee and an additional fee of five dollars and  
5 furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that the applicant  
6 was awarded the Purple Heart. ~~The additional fee shall be remitted~~  
7 ~~to the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery~~  
8 ~~System Operation Fund.~~ Any number of motor vehicles, trailers,  
9 semitrailers, or cabin trailers owned by the applicant may be so  
10 licensed at any one time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered  
11 under section 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.

12 (3) If license plates issued pursuant to this section are  
13 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall be  
14 issued replacement license plates upon request and without charge.

15 Sec. 8. Section 60-3,130.04, Revised Statutes Supplement,  
16 2013, is amended to read:

17 60-3,130.04 (1) An owner of a historical vehicle eligible  
18 for registration under section 60-3,130 may use a license plate  
19 or plates designed by this state in the year corresponding to the  
20 model year when the vehicle was manufactured in lieu of the plates  
21 designed pursuant to section 60-3,130.03 subject to the approval of  
22 the department. The department shall inspect the plate or plates  
23 and may approve the plate or plates if it is determined that the  
24 model-year license plate or plates are legible and serviceable and  
25 that the license plate numbers do not conflict with or duplicate  
26 other numbers assigned and in use. An original-issued license plate  
27 or plates that have been restored to original condition may be used

1 when approved by the department.

2 (2) The department may consult with a recognized car club  
3 in determining whether the year of the license plate or plates  
4 to be used corresponds to the model year when the vehicle was  
5 manufactured.

6 (3) If only one license plate is used on the vehicle, the  
7 license plate shall be placed on the rear of the vehicle. The owner  
8 of a historical vehicle may use only one plate on the vehicle even  
9 for years in which two license plates were issued for vehicles in  
10 general.

11 (4) License plates used pursuant to this section  
12 corresponding to the year of manufacture of the vehicle shall  
13 not be personalized message license plates, Pearl Harbor license  
14 plates, prisoner-of-war license plates, disabled veteran license  
15 plates, Purple Heart license plates, amateur radio station license  
16 plates, Nebraska Cornhusker Spirit Plates, handicapped or disabled  
17 person license plates, specialty license plates, ~~or~~ special  
18 interest motor vehicle license plates, or Military Honor Plates.

19 Sec. 9. (1) The department shall design license plates  
20 to be known as Military Honor Plates. The department shall create  
21 designs honoring persons who have served or are serving in the  
22 United States Army, United States Navy, United States Marine Corps,  
23 United States Coast Guard, United States Air Force, or National  
24 Guard. There shall be six designs, one for each of such armed  
25 forces reflecting its official emblem, official seal, or other  
26 official image. The issuance of plates for each of such armed  
27 forces shall be conditioned on the approval of the armed forces

1 owning the copyright to the official emblem, official seal, or  
2 other official image. A person may qualify for a Military Honor  
3 Plate by registering with the Department of Veterans' Affairs  
4 pursuant to section 80-414. The Department of Motor Vehicles shall  
5 verify the applicant's eligibility for a plate created pursuant  
6 to this section by consulting the registry established by the  
7 Department of Veterans' Affairs.

8 (2) The design shall be selected on the basis of limiting  
9 the manufacturing cost of each plate to an amount less than  
10 or equal to the amount charged for license plates pursuant to  
11 section 60-3,102. The Department of Motor Vehicles shall make  
12 applications available for each type of plate when it is designed.  
13 The department may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to  
14 carry out this section and section 10 of this act.

15 (3) One type of Military Honor Plates shall be  
16 alphanumeric plates. The department shall:

17 (a) Assign a designation up to five characters; and

18 (b) Not use a county designation.

19 (4) One type of Military Honor Plates shall be  
20 personalized message plates. Such plates shall be issued subject  
21 to the same conditions specified for personalized message license  
22 plates in section 60-3,118, except that a maximum of five  
23 characters may be used.

24 Sec. 10. (1) Beginning January 2, 2016, an eligible  
25 person may apply to the department for Military Honor Plates  
26 in lieu of regular license plates on an application prescribed  
27 and provided by the department for any motor vehicle, trailer,

1 semitrailer, or cabin trailer, except for a motor vehicle or  
2 trailer registered under section 60-3,198. An applicant receiving  
3 a Military Honor Plate for a farm truck with a gross weight of  
4 over sixteen tons shall affix the appropriate tonnage decal to  
5 the plate. The department shall make forms available for such  
6 applications through the county treasurers. The license plates  
7 shall be issued upon payment of the license fee described in  
8 subsection (2) of this section and verification by the department  
9 of an applicant's eligibility using the registry established by  
10 the Department of Veterans' Affairs pursuant to section 80-414.  
11 To be eligible an applicant shall be (a) active duty armed  
12 forces personnel serving in any of the armed forces listed in  
13 subsection (1) of section 9 of this act or (b) a veteran of any  
14 of such armed forces who was discharged or otherwise separated  
15 with a characterization of honorable or general (under honorable  
16 conditions). Any person using Military Honor Plates shall surrender  
17 the plates to the county treasurer if such person is no longer  
18 eligible for the plates. Regular plates shall be issued to any  
19 such person upon surrender of the Military Honor Plates for a  
20 three-dollar transfer fee and forfeiture of any of the remaining  
21 annual fee. The three-dollar transfer fee shall be remitted to the  
22 State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash  
23 Fund.

24 (2) (a) In addition to all other fees required for  
25 registration under the Motor Vehicle Registration Act, each  
26 application for initial issuance or renewal of alphanumeric  
27 Military Honor Plates shall be accompanied by a fee of five

1 dollars. County treasurers collecting fees pursuant to this  
2 subdivision shall remit them to the State Treasurer. The State  
3 Treasurer shall credit five dollars of the fee to the Nebraska  
4 Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund.

5 (b) In addition to all other fees required for  
6 registration under the Motor Vehicle Registration Act, each  
7 application for initial issuance or renewal of personalized  
8 message Military Honor Plates shall be accompanied by a fee of  
9 forty dollars. County treasurers collecting fees pursuant to this  
10 subdivision shall remit them to the State Treasurer. The State  
11 Treasurer shall credit twenty-five percent of the fee for initial  
12 issuance and renewal of such plates to the Department of Motor  
13 Vehicles Cash Fund and seventy-five percent of the fee to the  
14 Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund.

15 (3) When the Department of Motor Vehicles receives an  
16 application for Military Honor Plates, the department shall deliver  
17 the plates to the county treasurer of the county in which the  
18 motor vehicle or cabin trailer is registered. The county treasurer  
19 shall issue Military Honor Plates in lieu of regular license plates  
20 when the applicant complies with the other provisions of the Motor  
21 Vehicle Registration Act for registration of the motor vehicle  
22 or cabin trailer. If Military Honor Plates are lost, stolen, or  
23 mutilated, the licensee shall be issued replacement license plates  
24 upon request pursuant to section 60-3,157.

25 (4) The owner of a motor vehicle or cabin trailer bearing  
26 Military Honor Plates may apply to the county treasurer to have  
27 such plates transferred to a motor vehicle other than the vehicle

1 for which such plates were originally purchased if such vehicle is  
2 owned by the owner of the plates. The owner may have the unused  
3 portion of the fee for the plates credited to the other vehicle  
4 which will bear the plates at the rate of eight and one-third  
5 percent per month for each full month left in the registration  
6 period. Application for such transfer shall be accompanied by a fee  
7 of three dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall  
8 be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of  
9 Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.

10 (5) If the cost of manufacturing Military Honor Plates at  
11 any time exceeds the amount charged for license plates pursuant to  
12 section 60-3,102, any money to be credited to the Nebraska Veteran  
13 Cemetery System Operation Fund shall instead be credited first  
14 to the Highway Trust Fund in an amount equal to the difference  
15 between the manufacturing costs of Military Honor Plates and the  
16 amount charged pursuant to section 60-3,102 with respect to such  
17 plates and the remainder shall be credited to the Nebraska Veteran  
18 Cemetery System Operation Fund.

19 (6) If the director discovers evidence of fraud in an  
20 application for Military Honor Plates or that the holder is no  
21 longer eligible to have Military Honor Plates, the director may  
22 summarily cancel the plates and registration and send notice of the  
23 cancellation to the holder of the license plates.

24 Sec. 11. Section 80-414, Revised Statutes Supplement,  
25 2013, is amended to read:

26 80-414 (1) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall  
27 create and maintain a registry of residents of Nebraska who meet



1 the requirements of subdivision (1)(a) or (b) of section 10 of  
2 this act or subsection (1) of section 60-4,189. The Department of  
3 Veterans' Affairs may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations  
4 governing the establishment and maintenance of the registry. The  
5 registry may be used to assist the department in carrying out  
6 the duties of the department and shall provide for the collection  
7 of sufficient information to identify an individual who qualifies  
8 for Military Honor Plates or a notation of "veteran" on his or  
9 her operator's license or state identification card issued by the  
10 Department of Motor Vehicles. The registry may include information  
11 such as identifying information on an individual, an individual's  
12 records on active duty in the armed forces of the United States,  
13 or an individual's status of active duty, retired, discharged, or  
14 other.

15 (2) Any resident of Nebraska who meets the requirements  
16 of subdivision (1)(a) or (b) of section 10 of this act or  
17 subsection (1) of section 60-4,189 shall register with the  
18 Department of Veterans' Affairs using the registry created by  
19 this section before being eligible for Military Honor Plates or a  
20 notation of "veteran" on his or her operator's license or state  
21 identification card issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles. No  
22 person shall be deemed eligible until his or her status has been  
23 verified on the registry.

24 (3) The Department of Motor Vehicles may adopt and  
25 promulgate rules and regulations governing use of the registry  
26 of the Department of Veterans' Affairs for determination of  
27 eligibility for the issuance of Military Honor Plates or

1 the notation of "veteran" on operators' licenses and state  
2 identification cards.
