Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB209 (Harr) would amend sections 87-214 and 87-219 of the trade name statutes to repeal the requirement that a registrant of a trade name in the office of the Secretary of State shall file proof of newspaper publication of the trade name with the county clerk of the county where the principal office of the registrant is located. The bill would make no amendments in the provisions which require that proof of newspaper publication be filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
