Sec. 9-607(1)(c)(ii)(B) regulates keno games and states that, "the random selection of numbers by the computer, other electronic selection device, or electrically operated blower machine shall not occur within five minutes of the completion of the previous selection of random numbers."

LB 273 would reduce the time between games from five minutes to three minutes.
