Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR424 authorizes the appointment of a special committee of the Legislature to be known as the Department of Correctional Services Special Investigative Committee of the Legislature.

The committee would consist of five members appointed by the Executive Board.

The committee would be authorized to study the circumstances of Nikko Jenkins' incarceration and release from the Department of Correctional Services and to study certain department policies and procedures.

The committee would be required to issue a report no later than December 15, 2014.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment increases the membership on the committee from five senators to seven senators.
