Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 137 creates the State Fleet Card Program and creates a new fund, the State Fleet Card Distribution Fund, to allow rebates to be distributed back to fleet card users. The Department of Roads shall administer the fleet card program on behalf of political subdivisions and state government other than the University of Nebraska under a contract through the State Treasurer. The University of Nebraska will administer their own program.

It appears that LB 137 simply codifies a state fleet card program that is already in place, with one exception. That exception is that any rebates received are to be distributed proportionally back to the agencies and political subdivisions using the fleet cards. Currently these rebates are deposited into the General Fund.

Based on the total rebates earned in 2012 the annual revenue loss to the General Fund will be approximately \$96,324. This \$96,324 will now be distributed to the fleet card using agencies and political subdivisions. Since the bill has the emergency clause it is possible that this redistribution of rebates from the General Fund to the fleet card users will start in FY2012-13 depending on when the bill is passed and signed by the Governor.

No expenditure impact is expected since the State Fleet Card Program is already in existence and operating.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 137 establishes a state fleet card program and creates a distributive fund. The fleet card program will be administrated separately by the University of Nebraska and the Department of Roads under a contract through the State Treasurer.
