Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 137, as amended, creates the State Fleet Card Program. The Department of Roads will administer the fleet card program on behalf of political subdivisions and state government, other than the University of Nebraska, under a contract through the State Treasurer. The University of Nebraska will administer their own program.

The bill also creates a new fund, the State Fleet Card Fund, into which any rebates received are to be deposited. Rebates received on behalf of state agencies are transferred to the General Fund and rebates received on behalf of political subdivisions will be disbursed to individual political subdivisions consistent with their use of the fleet card. This new fund will be administered by the State Treasurer.

It appears that LB 137 simply codifies a state fleet card program that is already in place. Currently, any rebates are distributed in the same manner as provided for in the bill so this provision will not have a fiscal impact. No expenditure impact is expected since the State Fleet Card Program is already in existence and operating. LB 137 as amended will have no fiscal impact.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 137 as introduced establishes a state fleet card program. The fleet card program will be administrated separately by the University of Nebraska and the Department of Roads under a contract through the State Treasurer. The fleet card will be utilized as a payment card for gasoline, diesel, other fuels, and vehicle maintenance. LB 137 as introduced also allowed for any potential rebates received under the terms of the contract to be distributed to the program participants consistent with the volume spent.

Administrative Services, Transportation Services Bureau (TSB) will participate in the state fleet card program. Proposed amendment - AM 270 would allow for the rebates received under the terms of the contract to be credited to the General Fund and eliminate any potential rebates returning to TSB. This amendment has no fiscal impact to Administrative Services, TSB other than the loss of potential rebates.

Proposed amendment - AM 293 would allow rebates received on behalf of political subdivisions to be disbursed back to those political subdivisions. This amendment has no fiscal impact to Administrative Services, TSB.
