Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 250 allows for the purchase of trip permits for nonresident trucks, truck-tractors, buses or truck or truck-tractor combinations through internet sales from the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) web site. Currently, trip permits are available only at weighing stations or at other vendor stations for a cost of \$20 or \$25, depending upon the type of permit. The bill allows DMV to collect a 10% fee in addition to the trip permit fees currently authorized in statute.

DMV intends to contract with an on-line service to administer the electronic trip permits. The on-line vendor will charge applicants a fee to recoup their costs. DMV does not intend to charge an additional 10% fee at this time. If the department opted to charge a fee, the estimated increase in annual revenue would be \$41,385.
