LB 386 would require a county board or road overseer to give private landowners 10 days notice of their intent to enter said private property for the purposes listed in the bill (in general, the protection of county roads). The county board or road overseer shall also make a record the condition of the premises at the time of entry or make a record of the claimed encroachment of the road right-of-way that can be used in the event of damage to the private property.
