**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB 579, as amended by AM 663, amends the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, Section 53-117 regarding the powers, functions, and duties of the Liquor Control Commission.

The bill requires the Commission to enter into an agreement with the Nebraska State Patrol to hire up to 10 new members of the Patrol. The new members are to spend the majority of their time in administration and enforcement of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.

Based on information from the Liquor Control Commission regarding average salaries, benefits, and operating costs on previously introduced legislation, the estimated fiscal impact of LB 579, as amended by AM 663, is \$1,086,000 for FY2013-14 and \$869,000 for FY2014-15.
