LB 595 changes provisions of the Enhanced Wireless 911 Services Act.

Section 5 requires the Public Service Commission to conduct a study to examine issues surrounding the statewide implementation of next-generation 911. The Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund shall be used to conduct the study.

The PSC estimates the cost of such a study to be \$650,000. These funds will be used to hire consultants to perform the required study as outlined in the bill. This estimate is based on prior next-generation 911 studies that have been done in other states.

There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.

Section 5, subpart (1) provides that the Commission shall use the E911 fund to conduct a study to examine the issues surrounding the statewide implementation of next-generation 911. To accomplish this, the Commission would need to hire consultants, and based on the next-generation 911 studies that have been done in other states, our estimate of the spending authority needed would be up to \$650,000. Since there is sufficient cash available for this outlay, neither current program funding nor the E911 surcharge will be impacted by this action.
