Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 624 would allow law enforcement agencies to charge up to \$15 for a copy of an accident report prepared by a peace officer.

For those law enforcement agencies that already charge a fee of up to \$15 for these accident reports the passage of LB 624 will not have a fiscal impact. If the bill prompts a law enforcement agency to start charging a fee for these accident reports they will realize additional revenue commensurate with the fee that they set and the number of copies made.

A fiscal note request was made to the Department of Roads and their response indicates they already charge \$15 for a copy of these accident reports. It would appear the way the bill is drafted that it only applies to law enforcement agencies and departments and would have no fiscal impact on the Department of Roads.
