A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska County and City Lottery Act; to
2 amend sections 9-601, 9-603, and 9-615.01, Reissue
3 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to define and redefine
4 terms; to exempt keno writers from licensure as
5 prescribed; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the
6 original sections.

7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 9-601, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 9-601 Sections 9-601 to 9-653 and sections 3 and 5 of
4 this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska County and
5 City Lottery Act.

6 Sec. 2. Section 9-603, Reissue Revised Statutes of
7 Nebraska, is amended to read:

8 9-603 For purposes of the Nebraska County and City
9 Lottery Act, the definitions found in sections 9-603.02 to 9-618 and
10 section 3 of this act shall be used.

11 Sec. 3. (1) Keno writer means a person whose primary
12 responsibilities include accepting inside tickets or other requests
13 for wagers and payments of wagers from players, issuing outside
14 tickets, voiding tickets, and redeeming winning tickets.

15 (2) Keno writer does not include a keno manager, a
16 lottery operator, or any other person who is directly in charge of
17 the manual selection of numbers.

18 Sec. 4. Section 9-615.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
19 Nebraska, is amended to read:

20 9-615.01 Lottery worker shall mean any person, other than
21 a keno writer, who performs work directly related to the conduct of a
22 lottery, including, but not limited to, ~~ticket writing, winning~~
23 ~~number selection, winning number verification, prize payment to~~
24 ~~winners,~~ record keeping, shift checkout and review of keno writer
25 banks, and security.

1 Sec. 5. A person who is a keno writer and has no direct
2 responsibility for the selection of numbers shall not be considered a
3 lottery worker and shall not be required to be licensed for purposes
4 of the Nebraska County and City Lottery Act.

5 Sec. 6. Original sections 9-601, 9-603, and 9-615.01,
6 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
