A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend section 105,
2 Legislative Bill 195, One Hundred Third Legislature,
3 First Session, 2013; to appropriate funds to aid in
4 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 269, One
5 Hundred Third Legislature, First Session, 2013; to change
6 appropriations; to repeal the original section; and to
7 declare an emergency.

8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$85,000 from the
 2 General Fund for FY2013-14 to the Foster Care Review Office, for
 3 Program 353, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative
 4 Bill 269, One Hundred Third Legislature, First Session, 2013.

5 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
 6 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not
 7 exceed \$65,000 for FY2013-14.

8 Sec. 2. Section 105, Legislative Bill 195, One Hundred
 9 Third Legislature, First Session, 2013, is amended to read:

16 Sec. 3. If Legislative Bill 530, One Hundred Third
 17 Legislature, First Session, 2013, becomes law, there is hereby
 18 appropriated \$88,000 from the General Fund for FY2014-15 to the
 19 Foster Care Review Office, for Program 353, to aid in carrying out
 20 the provisions of Legislative Bill 269, One Hundred Third
 21 Legislature, First Session, 2013.

22 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
 23 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not
 24 exceed \$66,625 for FY2014-15.

1 Sec. 4. Original section 105, Legislative Bill 195, One
2 Hundred Third Legislature, First Session, 2013, is repealed.

3 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
4 when passed and approved according to law.
