A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend sections 2-259 and 2 2-264, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to county agricultural societies; to 3 4 repeal the original sections; and to declare an 5 emergency. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 2-259, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 2-259 Pursuant to a request by a county agricultural
- 4 society, the county board of any county may levy an additional levy
- 5 of three and five-tenths cents on each one hundred dollars of taxable
- 6 valuation, or any part thereof, for the purpose of acquiring an
- 7 interest in real property to comprise a portion or all of the county
- 8 fairgrounds, or for the purpose of capital construction on and
- 9 renovation, repair, improvement, and maintenance of the county
- 10 fairgrounds, over and above the operational tax levy authorized in
- 11 section 2-257, or for the purpose of purchasing equipment. Such levy
- 12 shall not exceed the amount actually required for such acquisition or
- work and shall be subject to section 77-3443.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 2-264, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 15 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 16 2-264 A county agricultural society may exchange its real
- 17 estate and improvements for other real estate or to sell its real
- 18 estate for the purpose of acquiring other real estate for
- 19 fairgrounds, and may make, execute, deliver, and accept all proper or
- 20 necessary conveyances in and about such exchange, sale, or purchase,
- 21 and the right of the county in the original grounds and improvements
- 22 as provided for in section 2-263 shall extend to the real estate
- 23 derived from exchange or purchase.
- 24 With the consent of the county board of the county within
- 25 which the real estate is located, a county agricultural society may

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1 exchange its real estate and improvements for other real estate and

- 2 improvements or may lease or sell its real estate and improvements
- 3 and may make, execute, deliver, and accept all proper or necessary
- 4 conveyances relating to such exchange, lease, sale, or purchase.
- 5 County board approval is not required for leases having a term of
- 6 less than ninety days. The right of the county to real estate and
- 7 improvements as provided in section 2-263 shall extend to real
- 8 estate, improvements, or proceeds derived from any exchange, sale, or
- 9 purchase of real estate or improvements acquired with the additional
- 10 tax levy provided in section 2-259.
- 11 A county agricultural society may purchase real estate
- 12 and improve the same. The payment of the purchase price may be
- 13 secured by mortgage or deed of trust.
- Sec. 3. Original sections 2-259 and 2-264, Reissue
- 15 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
- 16 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 17 when passed and approved according to law.
