A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to limited liability companies; to amend sections  
2 21-114 and 21-192, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;  
3 to change a provision relating to a change of address; to  
4 provide a fee; and to repeal the original sections.  
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Section 21-114, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3           21-114 (ULLCA 114) (a) A limited liability company or  
4 foreign limited liability company may change its designated office,  
5 its agent for service of process, or the address of its agent for  
6 service of process by delivering to the Secretary of State for filing  
7 a statement of change containing:

8           (1) the name of the company;

9           (2) the street and mailing addresses of its current  
10 designated office;

11           (3) if the current designated office is to be changed,  
12 the street and mailing addresses of the new designated office;

13           (4) the name and street and mailing addresses and post  
14 office box number, if any, of its current agent for service of  
15 process; and

16           (5) if the current agent for service of process or an  
17 address of the agent is to be changed, the new information.

18           (b) Subject to subsection (c) of section 21-121, a  
19 statement of change is effective when filed by the Secretary of  
20 State.

21           (c) An agent for service of process may change the  
22 agent's street and mailing addresses and post office box number, if  
23 any, for any limited liability company or foreign limited liability  
24 company for which the agent is designated by notifying the limited  
25 liability company or foreign limited liability company in writing of

1 the change containing the new information, and by delivering to the  
2 Secretary of State for filing a statement of change of address for an  
3 agent for service of process which complies with the requirements of  
4 subdivisions (a)(1), (4), and (5) of this section and states that the  
5 limited liability company or foreign limited liability company has  
6 been notified of the change.

7           Sec. 2. Section 21-192, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
8 Nebraska, is amended to read:

9           21-192 (1) The filing fee for all filings under the  
10 Nebraska Uniform Limited Liability Company Act, including amendments  
11 and name reservation, shall be ten dollars plus the recording fees  
12 set forth in subdivision (4) of section 33-101, except that the  
13 filing fee for filing a certificate of organization under section  
14 21-117 and for filing an application for a certificate of authority  
15 to transact business in this state as a foreign limited liability  
16 company under section 21-156 shall be one hundred dollars plus such  
17 recording fees and ten dollars for a certificate. The filing fee for  
18 filing a statement of change of address for an agent for service of  
19 process shall be ten dollars for each limited liability company or  
20 foreign limited liability company for which the agent is designated  
21 plus the recording fees set forth in subdivision (4) of section  
22 33-101. There shall be no recording fee collected for the filing of a  
23 biennial report required by section 21-125 or any corrections or  
24 amendments thereto.

25           (2) A fee of one dollar per page plus ten dollars per

1 certificate shall be paid for a certified copy of any document on  
2 file under the act.

3 (3) The fees for filings under the act shall be paid to  
4 the Secretary of State and remitted by him or her to the State  
5 Treasurer. The State Treasurer shall credit two-thirds of the fees to  
6 the General Fund and one-third of the fees to the Corporation Cash  
7 Fund.

8 Sec. 3. Original sections 21-114 and 21-192, Reissue  
9 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
