**LEGISLATIVE BILL 1075**

A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to government; to prohibit the employment of
- 2 certain persons by certain public entities.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. (1) A person who is elected or appointed to  
2 serve on the governing body of a political subdivision or the  
3 governing body of an agency of the executive department of the State  
4 of Nebraska which is created by the Constitution of Nebraska, by  
5 statute, or otherwise pursuant to law, including the Board of Regents  
6 of the University of Nebraska, or on an independent board,  
7 commission, bureau, committee, council, subunit, or other body  
8 created by the Constitution of Nebraska, by statute, or otherwise  
9 pursuant to law is not eligible for employment by the entity for two  
10 years after leaving such position.

11           (2) A person who appoints a member to serve on the  
12 governing body of a political subdivision or the governing body of an  
13 agency of the executive department of the State of Nebraska which is  
14 created by the Constitution of Nebraska, by statute, or otherwise  
15 pursuant to law, including the Board of Regents of the University of  
16 Nebraska, or on an independent board, commission, bureau, committee,  
17 council, subunit, or other body created by the Constitution of  
18 Nebraska, by statute, or otherwise pursuant to law is not eligible  
19 for employment by the entity for two years after leaving the position  
20 by virtue of which he or she made the appointment.
