A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act; to amend
2 section 53-180.06, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
3 to change provisions relating to documentary proof of
4 age; and to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 53-180.06, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 53-180.06 (1) To establish proof of age for the purpose
4 of purchasing or consuming alcoholic liquor, a person shall present
5 or display only a valid driver's or operator's license, Nebraska
6 state identification card, military identification card, alien
7 registration card, or passport.

8 (2) Every holder of a retail license may maintain, in a
9 separate book, a record of each person who has furnished documentary
10 proof of age for the purpose of making any purchase of alcoholic
11 liquor. The record shall show the name and address of the purchaser,
12 the date of the purchase, and a description of the identification
13 used and shall be signed by the purchaser.
