## A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to elections; to amend section 32-709, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 32-707, Revised
Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012; to change
provisions relating to political party conventions and
caucuses; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 32-707, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 3 32-707 (1) The county postprimary convention of a
- 4 political party shall be held in the county any time during the first
- 5 ten days in June following the statewide primary election at an hour
- 6 and place to be designated by the chairperson of the county central
- 7 committee of a political party. The county central committee
- 8 chairperson shall, after appropriate consultation with the central
- 9 committee, certify the date, time, and location of the convention to
- 10 the election commissioner or county clerk not later than the first
- 11 Tuesday in May preceding the primary election.
- 12 (2) The election commissioner or county clerk shall issue
- 13 certificates of election to each person elected at the statewide
- 14 primary election as a delegate to the county postprimary convention
- 15 of a political party and shall notify each person elected of the time
- 16 and place of the holding of such county postprimary convention. If
- 17 <u>delegates to the county postprimary convention are chosen at caucuses</u>
- 18 in accordance with section 32-709, the county central committee shall
- 19 be responsible for notifying each person chosen as a delegate of the
- 20 <u>time and place of the holding of the county postprimary convention.</u>
- 21 (3) The county central committee chairperson shall cause
- 22 to be published, at least fifteen days prior to the date of the
- 23 county postprimary convention, an official notice of the date, time,
- 24 and place of the convention in at least one newspaper of general
- 25 circulation within the county.

1  $\frac{(2)-(4)}{(2)}$  The election commissioner or county clerk shall

- 2 deliver to the temporary secretary of each county postprimary
- 3 convention of a political party the roll, properly certified, showing
- 4 the name and address of each delegate elected to such convention at
- 5 the statewide primary election. Upon receipt of such roll, the
- 6 convention shall organize and proceed with the transaction of
- 7 business which is properly before it.
- 8 (5) At the county postprimary convention, a A—county
- 9 chairperson, secretary, treasurer, and other officials may be
- 10 elected.
- 11 <u>(6)</u> The authority reposed in delegates to the county
- 12 postprimary convention by reason of their election shall be deemed
- 13 personal in its nature, and no such delegate may, by power of
- 14 attorney, by proxy, or in any other way, authorize any person in such
- 15 delegate's name or on such delegate's behalf to appear at such county
- 16 postprimary convention, cast ballots at the convention, or
- 17 participate in the organization or transaction of any business of the
- 18 convention. In case of a vacancy in the elected delegates, such
- 19 elected delegates present shall have the power to fill any vacancy
- 20 from the qualified registered voters of the precinct in which the
- 21 vacancy exists.
- Sec. 2. Section 32-709, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 23 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 24 32-709 Delegates to county conventions of political
- 25 parties may be <u>elected chosen</u> at precinct caucuses held in each

presidential election year. The state central committee of each 1 2 political party shall set the date for the caucus, and the county 3 chairperson for each party shall issue the call. Each and shall, on or before January 1, notify the Secretary of State of such date. The 4 5 county chairperson shall issue the call and file with the election 6 commissioner or county clerk notice of the meeting place time and 7 location of such caucus at least ten days prior to the date of the 8 caucus. The state central committee of each party shall draft rules of procedure to be followed at each caucus. If the state central 9 committee of a political party sets the date for a caucus, the 10 candidate filing form of any candidate who has filed with the 11 12 election commissioner or county clerk for the position of delegate 13 for the political party's postprimary convention shall be void and 14 the election commissioner or county clerk shall not accept any candidate filing forms for such position. 15 For purposes of this section, caucus shall mean means a 16 meeting of the legal voters of any political party assembled for the 17 18 purpose of choosing delegates to the county convention.
