A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to county veterans service offices; to amend  
2 section 80-410, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,  
3 2012; to change qualifications for county veterans  
4 service officers; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal  
5 the original section.  
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Section 80-410, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

3           80-410 (1) The Director of Veterans' Affairs, all members  
4 of the Veterans' Advisory Commission, all state service officers, all  
5 assistant state service officers, and all personnel, except certain  
6 special and clerical help, of the state veterans service offices  
7 shall have served in the armed forces of the United States during the  
8 dates set forth in section 80-401.01, shall have been discharged or  
9 otherwise separated with a characterization of honorable from such  
10 service, and shall have been bona fide residents of the State of  
11 Nebraska continuously for at least five years immediately prior to  
12 their assuming a position in any of the offices mentioned.

13           (2) All county veterans service officers shall have  
14 served on active duty in the armed forces of the United States, other  
15 than active duty for training, shall have been discharged or  
16 otherwise separated with a characterization of honorable from the  
17 service, and shall ~~have been~~ be bona fide residents of the State of  
18 Nebraska ~~continuously for at least five years immediately prior to~~  
19 assuming any such position.

20           (3) All members of the county veterans service committees  
21 and all personnel, except certain special and clerical help, of the  
22 county veterans service offices shall have all of the qualifications  
23 described in subsection (2) of this section, except that such persons  
24 may have been discharged or otherwise separated with a  
25 characterization of general (under honorable conditions).
