A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend section 37-201,
Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012, and section
84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2013; to appropriate
and transfer funds; to create a fund; to harmonize
provisions; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The Game and Parks State Park Improvement and

- 2 Maintenance Fund is created. The fund shall consist of transfers made
- 3 by the Legislature and any gifts, grants, bequests, or donations to
- 4 the fund. Money in the fund shall be used for repair, maintenance,
- 5 and improvements at state parks. Any money in the fund available for
- 6 investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant
- 7 <u>to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds</u>
- 8 <u>Investment Act.</u>
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 37-201, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 10 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 11 37-201 Sections 37-201 to 37-811 and 37-1501 to 37-1510
- 12 <u>and section 1 of this act</u> shall be known and may be cited as the Game
- 13 Law.
- Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated \$15,000,000 from the
- 15 Game and Parks State Park Improvement and Maintenance Fund to the
- 16 Game and Parks Commission for FY2014-15, for the purposes described
- in section 1 of this act.
- 18 Sec. 4. Section 84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 19 2013, is amended to read:
- 20 84-612 (1) There is hereby created within the state
- 21 treasury a fund known as the Cash Reserve Fund which shall be under
- 22 the direction of the State Treasurer. The fund shall only be used
- 23 pursuant to this section.
- 24 (2) The State Treasurer shall transfer funds from the
- 25 Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund upon certification by the

1 Director of Administrative Services that the current cash balance in

- 2 the General Fund is inadequate to meet current obligations. Such
- 3 certification shall include the dollar amount to be transferred. Any
- 4 transfers made pursuant to this subsection shall be reversed upon
- 5 notification by the Director of Administrative Services that
- 6 sufficient funds are available.
- 7 (3) In addition to receiving transfers from other funds,
- 8 the Cash Reserve Fund shall receive federal funds received by the
- 9 State of Nebraska for undesignated general government purposes,
- 10 federal revenue sharing, or general fiscal relief of the state.
- 11 (4) On July 7, 2009, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 12 five million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Roads
- 13 Operations Cash Fund. The Department of Roads shall use such funds to
- 14 provide the required state match for federal funding made available
- 15 to the state through congressional earmarks.
- 16 (5) The State Treasurer shall transfer a total of thirty-
- 17 seven million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund
- 18 on or before June 30, 2012, on such dates and in such amounts as
- 19 directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
- 20 Department of Administrative Services.
- 21 (6) The State Treasurer shall transfer a total of sixty-
- 22 eight million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund
- 23 on or before June 30, 2013, on such dates and in such amounts as
- 24 directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
- 25 Department of Administrative Services.

1 (7) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget

- 2 administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 3 Administrative Services, shall transfer not to exceed twelve million
- 4 dollars in total between July 1, 2011, and November 30, 2012, from
- 5 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund,
- 6 for ethanol production incentive credits, on such dates and in such
- 7 amounts as certified by the Tax Commissioner.
- 8 (8) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 9 administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 10 Administrative Services, shall transfer an amount equal to the total
- 11 amount transferred pursuant to subsection (7) of this section from
- 12 the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund to the Cash Reserve Fund
- 13 in such amounts as certified by the Tax Commissioner on or before
- 14 November 30, 2012.
- 15 (9) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 16 administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 17 Administrative Services, shall transfer eighty million dollars from
- 18 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund on or
- 19 before August 15, 2012.
- 20 (10) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 21 administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 22 Administrative Services, shall transfer one million dollars from the
- 23 Cash Reserve Fund to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund on or before
- 24 August 15, 2012.
- 25 (11) The State Treasurer shall transfer ten million

1 dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund on or before

- 2 June 30, 2013, on such date as directed by the budget administrator
- 3 of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.
- 4 (12) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 5 administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 6 Administrative Services, shall transfer not to exceed forty-three
- 7 million fifteen thousand four hundred fifty-nine dollars in total
- 8 from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund
- 9 between July 1, 2013, and June 30, 2017.
- 10 (13) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifteen million
- 11 <u>dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Game and Parks State Parks</u>
- 12 Improvement and Maintenance Fund on or before July 31, 2014, on such
- 13 dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of
- 14 the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.
