LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 291

Introduced by Schilz, 47.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to examine means by which to coordinate activities by state livestock animal health authorities with the activities of local livestock cruelty and neglect authorities. This resolution is not to examine whether the Department of Agriculture shall have a role as a primary complaint or investigative agency, but rather whether the department's interests, authorities, and resources with respect to livestock animal disease, carcass disposal, and biosecurity could be useful in assisting in the assessment and ultimate disposition of livestock seized by local authorities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

1. That the Agriculture Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
